

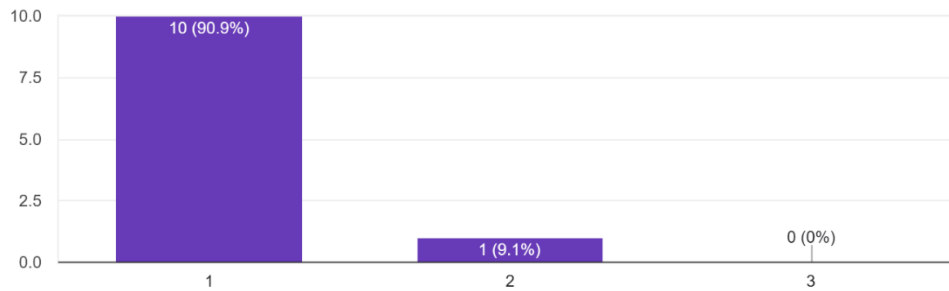
Reception Workshop Parent Feedback

We had 49 parents attending the meeting. We received 11 feedback responses.

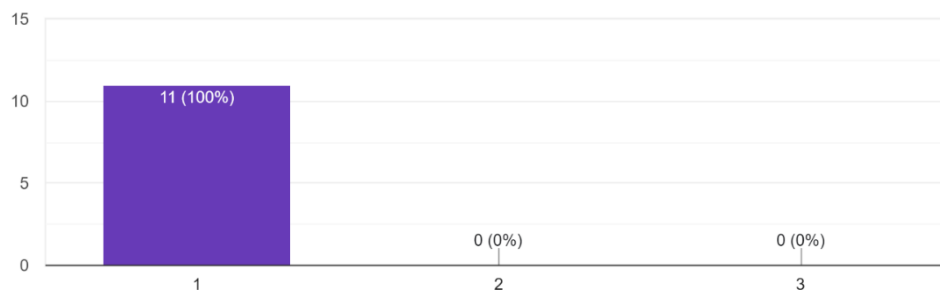
1. The workshop met your needs.

11 responses



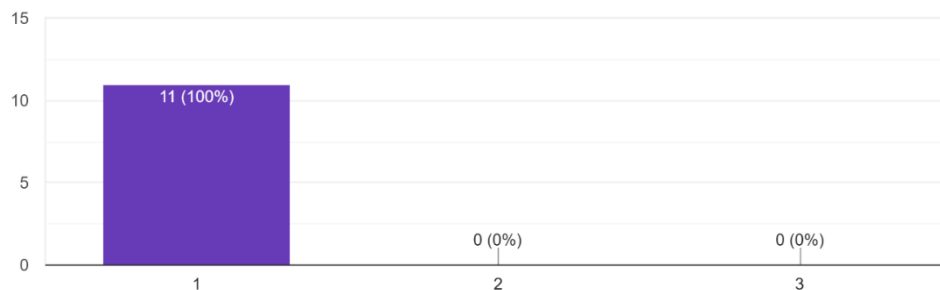
2. The presentation was informative.
