

Y2 Computing Workshop Feedback


Contextual Information


Responses

The following feedback was received -


1) Did you feel that the information provided was easy to understand?
7 responses




2) How useful did you find the workshop?

Implications

- Next Year's letter for QR codes will include screen shots for extra clarity.
- During the workshop, there were discussions about amount of screen time and lack of written homework and, subsequently handwriting practise. Handwriting homework is going to be started after Autumn half-term. Regarding screen time, advice from Nicola is now that it is not so much about how much screen time but more about how much purposeful, educational screen time.
- One class's children came in much later than the others so it may be that class where time was observed. Next year, ensure all children are in for 10-15 mins.
