


Year 1 Parent Meeting 2024

We had 57 parents attend the meeting. We received 8 responses from parents via Google Forms.


1. The workshop met your needs.

Implications

The content of the presentation shall remain the same as parents found the information useful and informative.

The workshop was not able to begin on time due to parents collecting their children and booking them in to the onsite crèche run by our staff. The high volume of children booked into the crèche therefore meant that the workshop ran slightly longer than the 30 minutes as advertised. It may be beneficial to run the workshop during the day to eliminate this process.

The workshop presentation is uploaded to the website to access and handouts are being distributed at consultation evening to ensure that all parents, whether they were able to attend the workshop or not, will have equal access to these documents. This information was shared with parents at the workshop.

We explained that login details would be sent home alongside the launch of the new spelling platform the following week as children were practising using them in school and there was a workshop available to parents to allow them to practise using these with their child in school. These were sent out with a letter explaining how to use them.

The computing workshop is within the school day to allow parents to work alongside their child.
