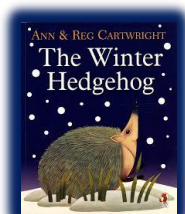


We have been having a wonderful time in the classroom, with the children fully engaged in their learning. Here is an overview of what the children have been working on.

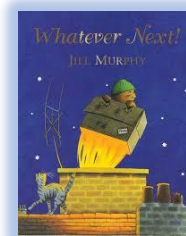
Nursery



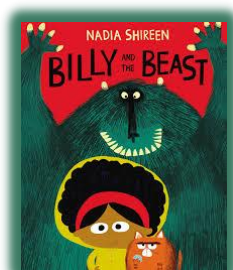
This week in Nursery, we have been embracing the start of winter! The children enjoyed reading *The Winter Hedgehog* and explored their creativity by building hedgehogs with playdough to strengthen their fine motor skills. In Expressive Arts and Design, they experimented with using forks as a painting tool, discovering new textures and effects. Our Christmas Grotto role play has been a hit, especially the 'hot chocolate station' where children practiced making drinks and using comparative language such as 'big', 'large', and 'small' to describe. In Maths, we focused on touch counting and finding 'big' and 'small'.

Reception

Reception have been working incredibly hard over the past few weeks! We have finished our focus on *Whatever Next* in Literacy and are now enjoying *Peace at Last*, another story by Jill Murphy. The children have been spotting similarities between the books, practising their phonics by listening for beginning, middle and end sounds in CVC words, and working on letter formation to write words. In Maths, we explored the composition of 4 and 5 using Numicon tiles and are beginning to recall some number bonds. In Understanding the World, we have talked about significant people in our lives, shared memories and explored technology, comparing old and new devices—the Beebots were a particular hit! This week, we are excited to begin learning about Winter.



Year 1



Last week, the children were thrilled to discover that a mysterious visitor had been in our classrooms! Muddy footprints, nibbled fruit, and scattered green fur revealed that a huge, friendly-looking creature with horns had wandered in because he was feeling a little hungry.

In English, the children created their own wanted posters to warn others, using their knowledge of statements, questions, and commands. This activity hooked them perfectly into our new story, *Billy and the Beast* by Nadia Shireen, and they were eager to begin reading it.

In D&T, the children have started sewing Christmas decorations for the hall tree, while in Science, they carried out some fieldwork to identify the signs of Winter. In Maths, we have been exploring number bonds to ten, using these to find related facts and solve problems. The children have also been busy practising for our Winter Performance and are very excited to share it with parents next week!

Year 2

In English, we have continued our work around the book 'Me and You'. We have looked at the alternative version of events for Goldilocks, where she is a young girl that gets lost and takes shelter in the home of the Three Bears. We have looked at retelling the story from different points of view, particularly focussing on the emotions of the characters. In Maths, we have continued to look at multiplication, thinking about how we can use arrays to show calculations. We have also learnt about money; identifying the value of different coins and calculating change from 20p and 50p. Our Gymnastics lessons are progressing well, we have learnt a variety of different rolls, jumps and leaps. We even had a go at using different hand apparatus, including hoops, ribbons and balls. In Geography lessons we have been looking at world maps and locating different continents and oceans.

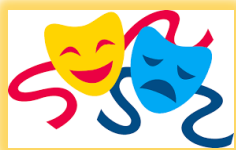
Year 1 - A Cup of Cheer Performance
