Contextual Information



The following feedback was received -


1) My child feels happy at this school.

50 responses




2) My child feels safe at this school.

50 responses




3) The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.

50 responses




4) My child has been bullied.

5) If you answered 'yes' to Q4, how far do you agree with this statement: 'The school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively'.


9 responses



This should have been 3 responses based on Q4, so it is hard to know which 3 were the genuine responses from parents who felt their child had been bullied.


6) When I have raised concerns with the school, they have been dealt with properly.


7) Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)?

8) If you answered 'yes' to Q7, how strongly do you agree with this statement: 'My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed'.


9 responses



This should have been 5 responses based on Q7, so it is hard to know which 5 were the genuine SEND parents.


9) The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year.


10) The school has high expectations for my child.


11) My child does well at this school.


12) The school lets me know how my child is doing.


13) There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.


14) My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school.


15) The school supports my child's wider personal development.

Implications

- Overall, the feedback is very positive and it is particularly pleasing that 100% of parents who responded are telling us that their child is happy at school, feels safe, does well at school and would recommend the school to others.
- 50% of parents felt that the school don't make them aware of what their child is doing. We need to raise awareness of the fortnightly updates in Newsletters and half-termly Curriculum Maps that get sent out. We also need to try and get more parents to the September Parent Workshops for each year group as these are full of information for parents about what their child will be doing in each year group.
- Areas of disagreement -
2% (1 response) disagreed with the statement that school lets parents know how well they are doing; 6% disagreed that their child can take part in clubs and activities; 4% disagreed that school supports their child's wider development.
All of these are very low numbers. The highest is about clubs and activities and this year the school have begun a new programme of clubs in each year group which hopefully will provide parents with a belief that there are clubs and activities available to all children from Reception to Year 2 beyond the Sports Club, Choir and Recorders that has previously been offered, primarily in KS1.
- 5 parents (10%) answered the question about their child having SEND however, more than 5 answered the following question about their child being supported so it is hard to know their exact feelings but there was no negative responses to this.
- Only 3 parents (6%) felt bullying had happened to their child and, similarly to the SEND question, more than 3 answered the follow up question but it is good to see that none of these disagreed that the school 'deals with bullying quickly and effectively'.
